### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

#### WHEN TO USE

SBK Brushwood Killer controls brambles, nettles, dock, other tough weeds, woody weeds and hardwood saplings in grassland and non-crop areas. Do not use on desired plants.

Apply from May to October (June to August for woody weeds) when soil is moist and weeds are actively growing. For tree stumps the best time for treatment is Autumn or Winter, avoiding April, May or June when the sap is rising.

A repeat treatment may be applied after six weeks. Apply a maximum of two treatments per season

Allow at least six weeks between application and replanting.

#### WHERE TO USE

Do not apply during drought or in freezing conditions, when rain is imminent or the grass is wet. Do not apply in windy weather. Direct spray away from water. Avoid drift onto broadleaved plants outside the target area. Keep off cultivated plants. May cause damage to lawns and other fine turf.




