PRECAUTIONS

Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/ face protection. Wash thoroughly after use. If SWALLOWED, call a POISON CENTRE or doctor/physician if you feel unwell, If ON SKIN, wash with plenty of water. If INHALED, remove person to fresh air and keep in a comfortable position. If IN EYES, rinse cautiously with cold water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses if present and easy to do so. Continue rinsing. If skin irritation occurs or if eye irritation persists seek medical attention. If specific treatment is needed, go see a doctor with the safety data sheet for this product.

HEALTH & SAFETY INFORMATION

Avoid ingestion, inhalation, skin & eye contact. Handle in accordance with good industrial hygiene practice and any legal requirements. Store in a cool and dry area with adequate ventilation. DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Apply Blue-Gem® to clearly mark the areas you have sprayed to avoid missing or overdosing areas. It is non-toxic and is compatible with herbicides, fungicides, insecticides, moss killers and fertilisers. Typically it will stain the treated area for 3-4 days and degrades in sunlight or is washed away with the rain.

Use Blue-Gem® at a rate of 125-300ml per 100 litres of water. When using on grass you may have to increase the rate to clearly see the treated grea.

Half fill the spray tank with clean water. Stir/agitate the water and add the required quantity of Blue-Gem®. Add pesticide or other treatment(s), then fill tank to the desired level and commence spraying.
